

THOMPSON CALLS FOR AID TO ROLL UP FLYNN VOTE

Getting Elizabeth Gurley Flynn onto the voting machine as a candidate for City Council was a thumping victory for democracy. Robert Thompson, World War II hero, told campaign workers Tuesday night at the People's Rights Party headquarters.

"But," he continued, "the fruits of that victory, the real possibility of a meaningful vote on Election Day, are not automatic."

A real vote, Thompson said, must be won the same way the ballot fight was won, by a nightly outpouring of dedicated canvassers. And, he added, a significant vote would have solid meaning far beyond the 24th Senatorial District.

Campaign co-chairmen Evelyn Wiener and Albert Blumberg announced that the campaign workers had set a goal of pre-election canvassing and Election Day covering of one-third of the 169 election districts in the Lower East Side. Concentration will be on those EDs where the best re-

sponse was obtained in the petition campaign.

As of last Tuesday, it was reported, canvassers and watchers for 20 districts had been enrolled. The aim is to double this figure by Sunday, when a general all-day canvass is planned to bring the campaign into high gear for the final ten days.
