

Implementation of Security

1. Phone- Home phone may be used in calling comrades in your unit and those people who you are involved in mass work with. Home phones may not be used for long distance calls to other comrades. (any number which is registered on your bill) This is very important and comrades should understand the necessity not to violate this aspect. Our class enemies could very easily make a connection between different members of our organization simply by comparing phone bills. Long distance calls must be made at a phone booth.
2. Phone Tree- All units must begin setting up a phone tree which is workable under all conditions. It will be used in emergencies. We have already had such an occurrence and it operated effectively stopping the potential trouble.
3. Factory work- Comrades in each unit should study hard the guide lines layed out in "Materials On The Organizational Plan For The District" on page 5.
4. Unit Meeting- This is where the development and unity of the organization is achieved. From this stand point, it is important to realize that we cannot allow penetration into our basic organizational form which would place us in jeopardy. If security is slack and not taken up in a good way, then we could allow ourselves to be broken and split apart.
  - A. Comrades should park two to three blocks away from where the unit meets unless you frequently visit the comrade who lives there. If this is so, do not change ~~the~~ your normal pattern.
  - B. New recruits should come to the meeting by themselves, so as we can forestall any connections that might be made. They should also arrive half an hour early.
  - C. There should be no talking on the phone about details of unit meeting. Comrades in other units cannot be told of particulars which take place in your unit. Only ~~political~~ political struggles and lines on different questions can be discussed between units.
  - D. Papers and stacks of books cannot be carried to a meeting exposed. They must be hidden.
5. Home- Our houses must reflect the life style of the local working class. Always neat and clean. Political pictures and banners should not be in living room and

rooms which ~~for~~ gatherings. Our politics must be reflected in our relationships with the masses and knowing the customs of the working class.

6. Technical Training- Each unit <sup>leader</sup> will appoint a person in charge of T.E. and P.E. training. Each unit member must have two weapons eventually; shotgun and a pistol. (The pistol should be a 38 special) Comrades must go to the range at least once a month.

Travel- All cadre will get passports as soon as possible. This should be a staggered process. International contacts should be given to your unit leader so as we start preparing ourselves for whatever lies in the road ahead.
