① disclosure - name, address, occupation of contributors

② public financing - // discriminatory definition of what constitutes a political party

federal laws

① - must turn over <sup>records on all contributors</sup> \$100+ ; keep records on anyone \$20 or more

many state + local laws

↳ <sup>wants</sup> willing to do it with us

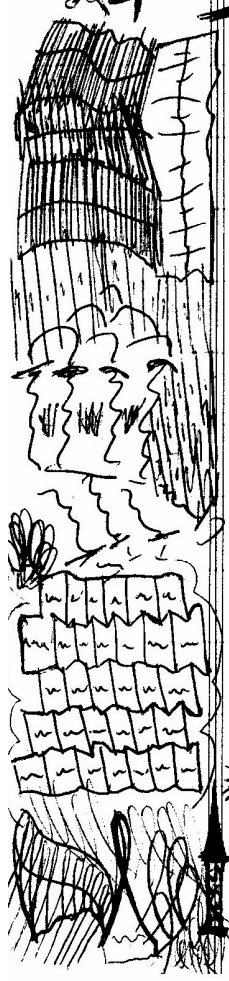
advantages to ACLU - money ; nationwide network of lawyers
