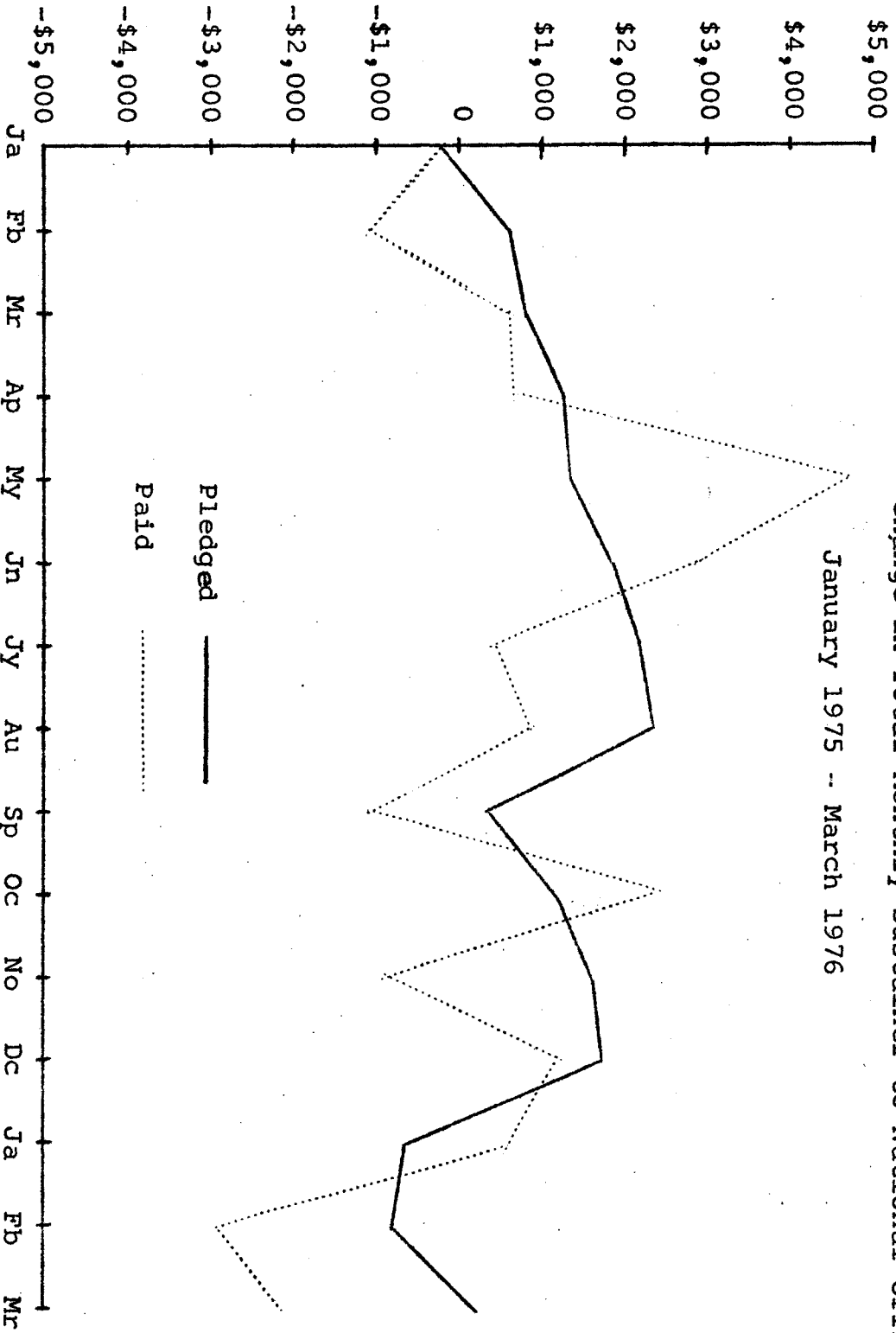
There are 52 center chapters; since January 1, 1976, 25 were chartered and 1 was dissolved.

There are 36 chapters in the region; since January 1, 1976, 5 were chartered and 6 were dissolved.

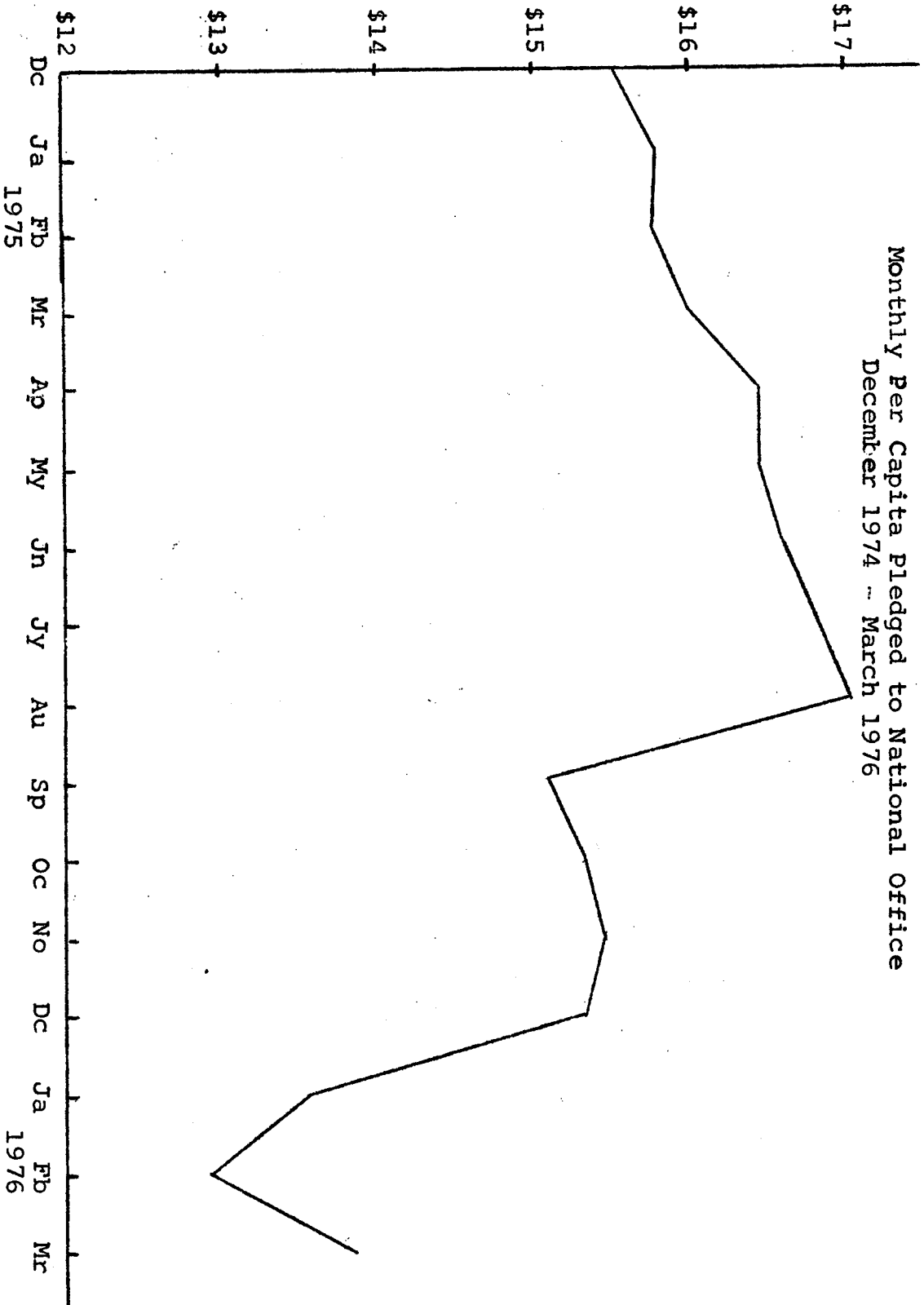

1976 NATIONAL CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE: Inquiries Received Jan. 1 - Mar. 30

The national campaign committee received 358 inquiries between Jan. 1 and Mar. 30, 1976. The inquiries came from people in 42 states plus the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Canal Zone, Canada, and army bases in Europe.

Two hundred of the inquiries were letters. Seventy-nine were Bill of Rights coupons. The remainder were assorted materials and Militant and Young Socialist coupons.
