Dear comrades,


The IMG Political Bureau at its meeting on February 23rd voted to request that the United Secretariat should consider the following resolution:

- " (i) to place Intercontinental Press /inprecor on the agenda of this U Sec Meeting.
- (ii) that the U. Sec point out to the Editor of IP/I that all resolutions carried by the IEC, U. Sec, U. Sec Bureau etc whether carried unanimously or by majority are resolutions of that body.
- (iii) that resolutions and editorials of the Bureau (or other leading bodies of the International), where so decided, should be prominently featured in the journal.
- (iv) that editorials/news analysis section, should reflect the decisions and resolutions of the United Secretariat or U. Sec Bureau "

We would like to ask that the appropriate steps are taken to place this resolution before the United Secretariat.

RESOLUTION ON INTERCONTINENTAL PRESS/INPRECOR

Carried at the IMG Political Bureau 23rd February, 1979.

I

The Political Bureau notes that IP/I has been centrally projecting a line on Kampuchea opposed to that decided by the leading bodies of the International. The resolution of the United Secretariat Bureau clearly raises the slogan of WITHDRAWAL OF THE VIETNAMESE TROOPS FROM KAMPUCHEA. This slogan has not been projected by IP/I. On the contrary its has been down played.

II

Therefore the PB decides to submit the following resolution to the next United Secretariat:

- (i) to place Intercontinental Press/Inprecor on the agenda of this U Sec meeting.
- (ii) that the U. Sec point out to the Editor of IP/I that all resolutions carried by the IEC, U. Sec, U. Sec bureau etc whether carried unanimously or by majority are resolutions of that body.
- (iii) that resolutions and editorials of the ~~Bureau~~ Bureau (or other leading bodies of the International), where so decided, should be prominently featured in the journal.
- (iv) that editorials/news analysis section, should reflect the decisions and resolution of the United Secretariat of U. Sec Bureau.

III

That the IMG Political Bureau makes a public statement pointing out that the line carried in IP/I does not reflect the line of the declaration of the United Secretariat Bureau on Kampuchea.
