Endorsers from SDS convention June 10: 41, 10 of them AAHBers.

We now have six GI endorsers, and have corresponded with GIs from Loring AFB (Me.), Ft. Benning, (Ga.), Ft. Devens (Mass.), McGuire AFB (N.J.), Ft. Eustis (Va.), Langley AFB (Va.), Ft. Campbell (Ky.), Vietnam (4 different GIs).

176 endorsers of Halstead and Boutelle are members of SDS.  
These 176 come from 93 different chapters of SDS.

Members of 14 Peace and Freedom groups have endorsed the SWP ticket.

78 members of black student groups have endorsed the campaign, as well as five Black Panthers.
