6. Election Campaign Report - Caroline

By centering their campaign activity around Choice '68, most locals are now functioning as regional campaign centers, sending out trailblazers to speak at many Choice '68 schools in their area, and sending out regional newsletters to people on the campaign mailing lists. Most locals are now regularly in touch with small groups of YSHBers in several cities in their state; for instance, Detroit has regular contact with YSHB groups in East Lansing, Ann Arbor, Kalamazoo and Saginaw.

The "Truth About McCarthy" is being used effectively to confront McCarthy supporters at all large meetings. The Bay Area has already ordered 1,000 copies of them.

A big aid in bringing our campaign to new campuses has been tours by local candidates such as Peter Camejo in California, Dan Styron in Illinois, Peter Buch in New York, and Bob Wilkinson in Wisconsin.
