TO ALL ORGANIZERS AND EDUCATION DIRECTORS

Dear Comrades,

One of the main activities of the National Education Department at the convention this year, aside from the organization of the post-convention educational conference, will be a workshop on internal party education. At the workshop there can be an exchange of experiences and an outline of educational perspectives for this coming fall.

Prior to the convention the National Education Department will be evaluating the experience we've had over the past spring and this summer, as well as assess the current status of branch educational programs and perspectives. In order to have a meaningful discussion, we will need factual information about educational projections on the branch level, the experience of the branch in carrying out these projections, and what the current educational needs of the branch are.

It would be very helpful if you would prepare a report on branch education and forward a copy to the National Education Department before July 23. Such a report should contain the following information:

1. Projections made by the branch for educational activities this past spring, including topics, number of classes per week, teachers, number of weeks of the series, amount of reading, and finally the degree of success of the series.
2. Projections on summer education, including the same information as above.
3. A general evaluation of the status of education in the branch. This should include your estimation of how much of the assigned reading was done in the spring and summer activities, what percentage of the branch took part in the educational programs, and what topics you think would be particularly useful for the education of branch members this coming fall and spring.
