

HANDS OFF CHILE!

After Spain in 1936, Indonesia in 1965, Greece in 1966 and Bolivia in 1971; the Chilean bourgeoisie, with the help of Yankee imperialism, has shown how much it respects its own laws when its power is menaced. For three years, Allende and Popular Unity allowed people to believe that it was possible to construct socialism in the framework of the old bourgeois institutions. In giving respect to legalism, the parties of the left permitted the bourgeoisie to reinforce itself, and to arm itself while at the same time refusing to arm the proletariat. Once again, reformism is smashed by an army with a so-called "apolitical" reputation.

The coup in Chile is a terrible blow against the entire international workers movement. While the Chilean workers, disarmed politically and militarily by their reformist leadership, attempt to resist, it is crucial that a strong solidarity movement rise up everywhere in the world.

Chile has become another example: reaction or revolution--that is the choice that must be made. There are no half measures.

The Young Socialist Alliance calls for solidarity with the struggle of the Chilean workers and peasants until the final victory of the socialist revolution.
