Dear Comrades,


We have been informed that our comrades in Europe are publishing the first edition of Leon Trotsky's Revolution Betrayed in Russian. They are utilizing the photo-offset process to reproduce the typewritten Russian manuscript, which includes handwritten corrections by Trotsky.

Besides the copies intended for reading inside the Soviet Union, they are publishing an additional 300 copies to be put on sale for institutions. The hope is to get sufficient income from this to defray substantially the cost of producing the book. These copies will be sold for \$20.00.

There may be some comrades or sympathizers who would like a copy for their own use, either because they read Russian or for other reasons. For such comrades a special offer is being made. They can get a copy for \$10, which includes the cost of mailing.
