25 Per Cent of the A. F. of L. Jobless, Says President Green Labor in general is suffering from overproduction, and approximately

25 per cent of the trades members of the American Federation of Labor are out of employment, although the industrial condition of the country as a whole is eood.

This, in brief, is the information conveyed to the President Coolidge by William Green, president of the American Federation of Labor, at a recent summer White House luncheon.

Furthermore said Mr. Green, according to the Chicago Journal of Commerce correspondent, "We can only re-adjust our economic life to the constant increase in the production of manufactured articles through a reduction in the hours of labor. A shorter work day is not only based upon sound economic reasons, but is justiliable from the humane point of view."

Troops Used to Conscript Negro Labor in Miami

Colored Workers Seized at Point of Gun and Forced to Work

MIAMI, Fla .- (Special) -- Soldiers of the Florida National Guard tonight patrolled Miami's black belt of 20,000 Negroes to prevent another outbreak of the rioting in which two United States sailors and three Negroes were shot and seriously wounded late today. As the patrols of four men each with buyonets fixed kept watch in and on the edge of the section, Col. V. B. Collins, commander of the troops, had two hundred men and auty trucks on duty.

gro labor was put into effect immediately after the hurricane and still continues, and it is said the Negroes have resented it.

Necessity has made the conscription methods rather severe. A group of white citizens or soldiers would take a big automobile truck, drive towards the Negro quarter and pick up every Negro it passed on the street.

The conscripting was done under the menace of guns and no excuse on the parts of the Negroes went. It was simply "get in that truck" and later, "get down and go to work."

Many of the Negroes were said to have been on their way to jobs, and these were forced to work with the ones who were idle.

"European state owned enterprises fail; going back to private ownership," to good news in American newspapers. Wall Street's belief, and incidentally there's less risk of losing their money when successful state enterprises are the pledge for it.

The outstanding success of the international bankers was the Dawes plans handing over the "best railroad system in Europe," the German state-owned roads, to private control.

Mussolini has been the most acquiescent along this bankers' route, his most recent gift being the telephone system of northern Italy.

The bankers trust magnates have found a way by which they think they can defeat Socialism just as it is on the point of a mighty Victory all over Europe. Through the control of money and credit the very life blood of na-tions under the present system—they
