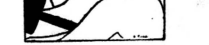

Insurrection against Bolsheviks

Local districts broke out on August 28th in remote regions. The insurrection was led by local officials and was supported by the local population. The Bolshevik government has taken measures to suppress the insurrection.

Character of the Insurrection

It does not seem true, as is asserted by the more enthusiastic and less intelligent Georgian Bolsheviks, that the insurrection was a purely local affair. It was a result of the economic and social conditions of the region.

On March 17th, the Georgian Menchevist Government was driven out of Tiflis and obliged to flee for peace, which was arranged by Moscow. The Menchevist Government left for Paris, taking the contents of the treasury with them.

In spite of the conditions concerning the war and constant change of government, the production of the nationalized industries has increased by 25 per cent as compared with 1922.
