SIMONS' NEWS FIGHT AGAINST MAJON BERRY Brings Suit or Lost Time Compensation

NEW YORK.—David Simons, who was president of New York Workmen's Union No. 25, which Berry killed after breaking the 1923 strike, has filed a suit for reinstatement in the International Union. The Supreme Court gave a verdict for Simons in the first round of the fight, but was reversed by the appellate division. The court of appeals decision: "Finlay was a member in good standing of the defendants' union, and subject to expulsion only upon written charges and after a hearing upon notice.
