Tenant Bill

From Hattiesville News Int.

A bill has been introduced in both houses of the state legislature, the effect of which would be to enable the tenant farmer to retain the value of the land he has improved, tools, etc., should be required to pay a higher price for the same.

One-fourth of the value of the cotton, while renters who are furnished with tools, food, etc., by the landlord shall not be required to pay more than one-half.

As it is an administration measure, the bill is not likely to be introduced to the matter. The proceedings would be civil. In short, it makes the tenant a partner in the profits of the land he occupies.

Of course this bill is merely a result of socialist agitation in this state, and is a direct result of the efforts of the socialist leaders proposing this temporary makeshift to stave off the wrath of the tenant.

If passed the law will have a considerable effect in lowering the price of cotton, which in many cases exceed 87 cents per bale, and more than the third and fourth.
