







REPORT CLAIMS REVER MEN UNEMPLOYED

New York Labor Department States That There is an Improvement for 1929 Over 1928.

An improvement in the condition of the unemployed in New York state in 1929 over 1928 is noted by the State Department of Labor in its quarterly bulletin published yesterday.

The percentages at the end of each month in 1929 were from 7 to 19 points below those of the same dates in 1928, and the mean percentage in 1929 was 18.5 as against 27.7 in 1928 and 22.7 in 1927.
