

EMULATING COMRADE LI CH'UAN-HUA IN STUDYING
AND USING CHAIRMAN MAO'S WORKS UNDER
REAL LIFE CONDITIONS

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Just when the proletarian revolutionaries throughout the country, using their pen as their weapon, launched a fierce offensive against the power-holders inside the party who follow a capitalist road; just when they are completely purging the party of the poison left by the capitalist reactionary line of Liu Shao-chi and Teng Hsiao-ping, a counter-current of capitalist comeback rose all over the country and at different levels. Szechwan is one of the areas where the two lines and the two roads are in the acutest conflict and struggle.

On 6 May, Comrade Li Ch'uan-hua, a model member of our Tung-fang Hung Commune and an excellent Red Guard fighter for Mao Tse-tung's thought was shot to death by the "Industrial Army", a tool of the small handful of power-holders in the Szechwan party who follow a capitalist road. With profound grief and incomparable hatred, we are mourning our dear fellow fighter.

Comrade Li Ch'uan-hua had an unlimited amount of love toward the party and Chairman Mao. He had unconditional faith in the ever-triumphant Mao Tse-tung's thought. For a long time, he insisted on studying and using Chairman Mao's works in real life conditions. In his work, Comrade Li was honest, earnest and whole-heartedly for the people. In the Great Proletarian Cultural Revolution he always held high the revolutionary flags, stood firmly on the side of the revolutionary line of Chairman Mao, and waged a resolute struggle against the small handful of power-holders within the College and the Geology Department who followed a capitalist road. He was a veteran of the gallant "High Banner Fearless" fighting unit. During the nationwide mobilization he rushed to the Chengtu area and fought side by side with the proletarian revolutionaries there courageously and persistently. The "Industrial Army" which was the tool of a small handful of power-holders

inside the party headed by Li Ching-ch'uan who follow a capitalist road, hated Comrade Li Ch'uan-hua profoundly and did their best to persecute him. Bloody debt must be repaid in blood. The blood of our heroes will never be shed in vain. We must turn sadness and grief into power. One Comrade Li Ch'uan-hua falls, but thousands upon thousands of Li Ch'uan-hua's rise up again. It is our wish to emulate Comrade Li. Our Tung-fang Hung Revolutionary Committee is issuing this special notice urging all of us to emulate Comrade Li Ch'uan-hua.

1. Like Comrade Li Ch'uan-hua in his studying and using Chairman Mao's works in real life conditions, we must consider the "Old Three Chapters" our motto. We must study and use during our struggles, and when we are conducting criticism. We must resolutely answer the call of the Peking Municipal Revolutionary Committee to study and use Chairman Mao's works in real life conditions. We must cause the campaign of studying and using Chairman Mao's works to rise to a new height.

2. Like Comrade Li we must be forever loyal to Chairman Mao and to Mao Tse-tung's thought. DOWN WITH LI CHING-CH'UAN, LIBERATE GREAT SOUTHWEST

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In the evening of 8 May, more than forty thousand people from more than 120 organizations and units of our College met at a big rally to send off the fellow fighters from the Great Southwest to fight their way back to their home territory. The revolutionary masses attending the rally were highly enthusiastic. Their slogans and cheers reverberated through the clouds. Warmly they cheered the resolutions and decisions of the Party Central with regard to Szechwan. Loudly they shouted: "Down with Liu Shao-chi!! Down with Li Ching-ch'uan!"

Those who attended the rally included Chang Kuo-hua (1728 0948 5478), First Political Commissar of the Chengtu Military District and Chief of the Preparatory Section of the Szechwan Revolutionary Committee; Liang Hsing-chu (2733 5281 0443), Commander of the Chengtu Military District and Deputy Chief of the Preparatory Section of the Szechwan Revolutionary Committee; Deputy Preparatory Section Chief Liu Chieh-t'ing (0491 3381 2185) of the Szechwan Revolutionary Committee; and Chang Hsi-t'ing (1728 6007 2185), member of the Preparatory Section of the Szechwan Revolutionary Committee.

Greeted by enthusiastic applause Comrade Chang Kuo-hua said: "On behalf of Commander Liang, I am sending my greetings to our revolutionary fellow fighters. We must support the proletarian revolutionaries, strengthen the ranks of the revolutionary leftists, and resolutely smash the biggest power-holder Li Ching-ch'uan of the Szechwan Party who follows the capitalist line. Comrade Chang Kuo-hua also expressed thanks to the red representative congress of the Capital city colleges. He said: "Comrade Li Ch'uan-hua was truly Chairman Mao's little red soldier. We must emulate him."

Comrade Liang Hsin-chu read the resolution passed by the Party Central in connection with the Szechwan problem. Comrade Liu Chieh-t'ing also spoke. He said: "We thank the comrades of the Liaison Station set up by the Capital colleges in the Southwest for their contributions to the Great Cultural Revolution in Szechwan. We must fight our way back home. We must thoroughly carry out the revolution."

When the rally was going on, Comrade Li Ch'uan-hua's elder brother rushed to Peking specially from Shantung to be present. He was given a rousing applause and welcome. Comrade Wang Ta-pin (3769 1129 6333), Standing Committee Member of the Peking Municipal Revolutionary Committee, said amid hearty applauses: "The suffering of the revolutionary fellow fighters in Szechwan is the suffering inflicted on us. Their victory is likewise our victory. We, the Tung-fang Hung fighters firmly support the Szechwan revolutionary rebels. You and we forever fight alongside each other and enjoy victory together."

A fighting spirit prevailed throughout the rally. It was a rally of unity, of struggle, and of victory.

Up to 10:30 in the evening when this report was sent, the rally was still going strong.

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
